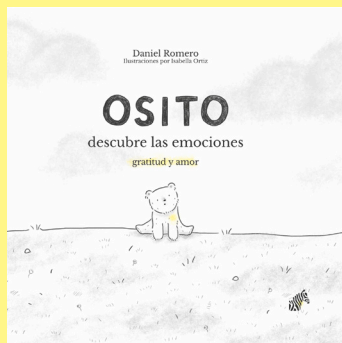

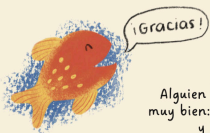

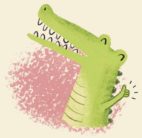

THE ORANGE ZEBRA

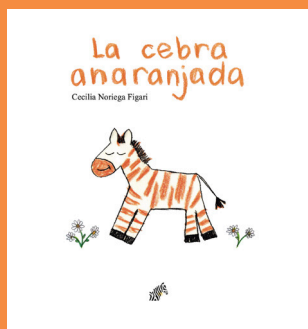

A little orange zebra plays happily and carefree in a farm, among pigs, frogs, and butterflies.

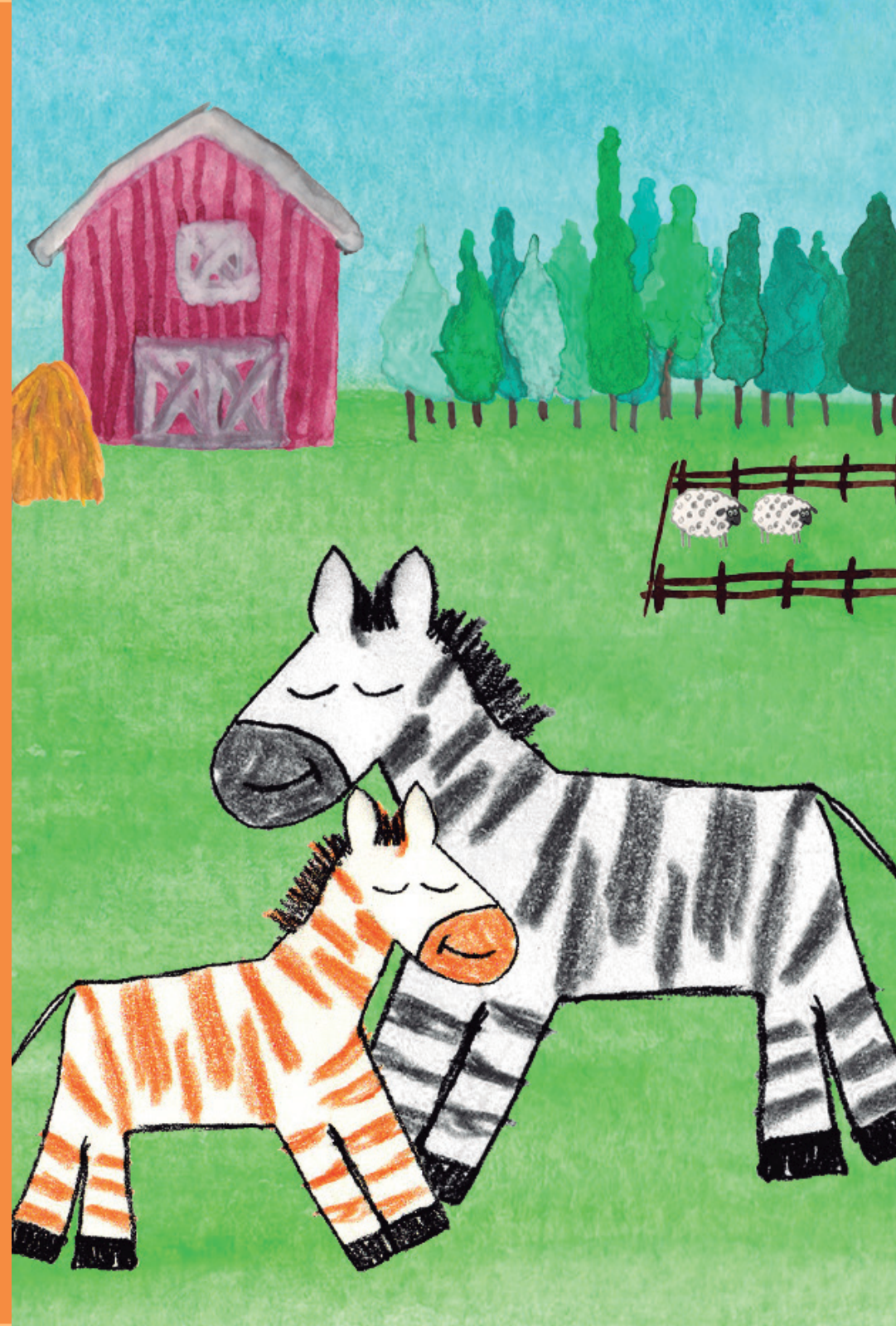

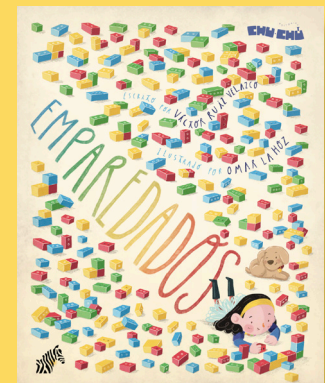
